Clark, Charles S. “Chasing Revere.” *The Review of American History* 6.12. (29 March 2000): 265-288.

Clark explores the events surrounding Paul Revere’s ride to spread the word about the approach of the British troops. He details the events that occurred on the night of April 18, 1775, providing a timeline. Clark is considered the foremost expert on matters surrounding the American Revolution, so his information in this article is considered a valid. Because his article is based on primary documentation, his assessment of this event is useful for research surrounding this event and can be used for comparison with Longfellow’s poem.
