<u>Prompt</u>

Write an expository essay in which you infer how the mother would have reacted to Karl's last moments by analyzing her character in "The Sunflower". Summarize what we know about the mother's character and how that contributes to your thoughts on her reaction to Karl's last moments. Use evidence from the text to analyze what is said explicitly as well as what is implied.
