- 1. In the opening paragraph, what problem does Norgay describe that makes the climb more difficult than they expected?
- 2. INFER: Edmund Hillary hired Tenzing Norgay as his guide. But on page 40, at the end of the second paragraph, Norgay says "We were partners." What does this imply about Norgay's point of view about the expedition?
- 3. Find 3 other examples at the beginning or end of sentences that give you hints about Norgay's perspective.
- 4. INFER: Do you think Norgay and Hillary feel differently about who is the leader? How do you think each feels?
- 5. What is the mood of the story so far?
- 6. Identify a fact and an opinion in the paragraph that begins "I have thought."
- 7. Do you think you would agree with Norgay's opinions about the climb if you were there? Why or why not?
- 8. What is Norgay's opinion of people who wanted to know which man got to the summit first?
